## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Judges decisions are final. No person may approach a judge regarding a decision or other matters without first obtaining consent from the Steward. Anyone disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and will forfeit all entry fees.
2. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide the classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, pickets and brush.
4. Championship and reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Champion and reserve will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points in the over fence classes in their divisions. In addition to these points, only those horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the under-saddle classes. Points to be awarded through the first six places: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
5. A trophy and/or cash and ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
6. No numbers taken for warm-up after 7:30 a.m.
7. Prize money will be deducted from the total entry fees.
8. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.
9. Entry Fee: \$35.00 per class unless otherwise stated. Warm up fee \$20.00, Office fee \$28.00, Stalls \$40, Post entry fee: \$25. Returned check fee \$50
11. Indoor Arena 75 x 150 with a well-groomed sand-based footing. Outdoor Warm-Up at least 100 x 200 with sand footing. Lunging is available in the indoor ring or upper paddock. Schooling permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating this rule will forfeit fees and not be allowed to show.
12. Post Entries accepted the day of the show with \$25 post entry fee. No penalty for adding additional classes the day of the show.
13. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a

motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

14. Dogs must be leashed at all times on Cornerstone property.

15. Exhibitors or trainers found cleaning out their trailers onto the grounds will be charged a \$50 grounds fee- NO CLEANING OUT TRAILERS, PLEASE.

16. It is compulsory for all persons when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

17. The committee reserves the right to vary or change horse show officials or judges. Warning- Under Massachusetts law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities pursuant to Chapter 12B Section 2D of the General laws.

### HUNTER DIVISIONS

#### **MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER DIVISION Rated "C" by NEHC & MHC Fences 2'6"**

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not show in classes with fences over 3' or higher within the past two show years. Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at Judge's discretion. Height of fences 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count.

Junior Exhibitors 15—17 years of age must be eligible for Intermediate Equitation over Fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Height of fences 3' for horses, large ponies 2'6", small and medium ponies 2', spreads not to exceed fence height. If entries warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except Equitation. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into the regular pony hunter division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

#### **LEADLINE SUITABLILITY & EQUITATION**

Open to riders who have not reached their 7th birthday and have not competed in any other classes in a USEF recognized show other than leadline. Entries may be asked to trot. Riders to be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. An adult is required to lead each entry.

#### **WALK TROT**

Open to riders 10 years and under who have not competed in any class requiring them to canter or jump at any recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any short stirrup

classes. Riders will be asked to walk and trot in both directions of the ring. They will be judged on position and ability to control their mount. Diagonals will be considered

### **JUNIOR/ADULT WALK TROT (NEHC and MHC Unrated)**

Open to riders 10 years and over who have not competed in any class requiring them to canter or jump at any recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any short stirrup classes. Riders will be asked to walk and trot in both directions of the ring. They will be judged on position and ability to control their mount. Diagonals will be considered

### **SHORT STIRRUP**

Open to riders 12 years of age and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or class in a show with fences exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and Pet Type Pony classes. Course no to exceed eight fences, fences not to exceed 18".

### **MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION**

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at any recognized shows in Adult Equitation Classes. (Classes 7,8,10)

### **HUNTER DIVISIONS**

Championship and Reserve shall be awarded to two of the top four horses that have acquired the most points performing over fences. In addition to these points, only these horses shall receive points for ribbons won in under saddle class. All over fences classes to be judged on performance and soundness. Jogging for soundness at judge's discretion.

### **AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER (Combined 18-35 and Over 35)**

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horse/Rider combination is not eligible for any other MHC, NEHC, or USEF rated classes. Horse may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Height of fences 3' spread not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by Adults, suitability to count. Exception: Equitation and Pleasure classes.

### **MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER**

Open to horse and ponies ridden by Amateur Adults. Fences 2'6". Rider may not cross enter into Amateur Adult Hunter Division.

### **CHILDREN'S/ADULT SPECIAL HUNTER**

Open to amateur adult and junior riders. No professionals. Open to horse and ponies that have not jumped 3" or over in the previous year, OR riders that have not shown at 3' or over in the previous year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". No in and outs. (Classes 25, 26, 27, 28)



## **CHILDRENS HUNTER**

To be shown by Junior Exhibitors. Exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year. HORSE- fences 3' PONIES- fences 2' for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies.

## **JUNIOR HUNTER**

Open to horses of any age. Fences height 3'3"-3'6" (depending on division). All classes to be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on manners. Extreme speed penalized.

## **HUNTER PLEASURE**

Open to all horse of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. Shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required.

**LOW HUNTER** - Open to all horse and ponies.

**PRE-ADULT and PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTERS** – Open to riders 13 years of age and older and amateur adults who have not competed at any other show or class where the jumps exceeded 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider (Classes 3,4,12)

## **EQUITATION**

**CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** – Exhibitors must be eligible for Children's Hunter. Riders may not enter into any other class at the same show where fences exceed 3'. Fences for horses and large ponies (2'6") and small/medium ponies (2'0"). (Classes 29, 30, 31)

## **MEDALS**

9. **DOWNEAST MODIFIED AM/AD MEDAL** Open to riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Riders shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". 25% of contestants, at least 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. Testing optional. (USEF Tests 1-8)

19. **DOWNEAST AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL** Open to amateur riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'6"-2'9". 25% of contestants, at least 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. Testing optional. (USEF Tests 1-19).

20. **MHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL\*** Open to adult members of MHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6" to 2'9", with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1— 17). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course.

21. **NEHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL** All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'0" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests (USEF Tests 1-19) of the top four competitors may be

requested at the judge's discretion. To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course.

**23. DOVER SADDLERY ADULT MEDAL** Open to all members of the USEF or CEF who are eligible to compete in the Amateur Adult Hunter section at this show. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a jumper or hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles not permitted. The top 4 riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1—19. An open numerical scoring system will be used for the first round and scores announced at the completion of their round.

**69. DOWNEAST SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL** Open to riders 12 years of age and under, competing on horses or ponies. All ages (Short and Long Stirrup) compete together at the qualifying shows, but age groups will be divided at the finals. Riders must not have shown over fences that exceed 18". Riders shall be required to perform a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". 25% of contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional, verbal recommended. USEF tests 1-8.

**32. MHC HUNT SEAT MINI-MEDAL\*** Entry Fee: \$40.00 Open to junior members of the MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday and have not competed in classes in which entry is required to jump higher than 3'0". All competitors are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6, excluding combinations, at a height not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual tests may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-8). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. Riders may continue to compete in this class once qualified.

**33. DOWNEAST MODIFIED JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to riders 17 years of age and under, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights will be 2'3". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional.

**44 DOWNEAST JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to riders 17 years of age and under, competing on horses or ponies. Riders shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional. USEF tests 1-19

**45 MHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL** Open to all members of MHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeded 3'0". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

**47. PYRANHA CHILDRENS MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the USEF or CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6". All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. The top four riders, or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1– 19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round with scores announced at the completion of the round

**48. NEHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the NEHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed

3'3" with at least change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1—19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals.

**51. MARSHALL & STERLING JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to Junior Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. May not be combined with any other M&S Medal

**108. MHJ Adult Medal (2)** Open to all Amateur Adult competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least 2 changes of direction and a combination. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2020. After August 1, 2020 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class

**109. MHJ Adult Mini-Medal (2)** Open to Amateur Adults who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' in the current year. To perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal or the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. At least 2 riders must complete the course. **110. MHC Adult Mini-Medal (4)** Open to Adult Members of the MHC who have not jumped 2'9" or higher in the past 2 years. All contestants are to perform over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combinations and a height not to exceed 2'6" for horses and ponies. To fill a class, 4 must complete the course. 10 points needed to qualify. May continue to compete after qualifying.

**111. MHJ Mini-Medal (2)** Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, with the exception of maiden and novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Competitors may cross enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the Finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2020. After August 1, 2020, only those riders not qualified may compete in the Class.

**112. MHJ Children's Medal (2)** Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height, including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. The same horse must be used in all phases. Sm/med ponies to jump 2' and large ponies/horses to jump 2'6". Only one rider per horse. Competitors may not cross enter into the MHJ Mini Medal or NEHJ Junior Talent Medal at the Finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2020. After August 1, 2020, only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

**113. MHJ Junior Medal (2)** Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 6 fences not exceeding 3'. Competitors may cross enter in the NEHJ Junior Talent Medal. To fill a class, at least

two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2020. After August 1, 2020, only those riders not qualified may compete in the classes

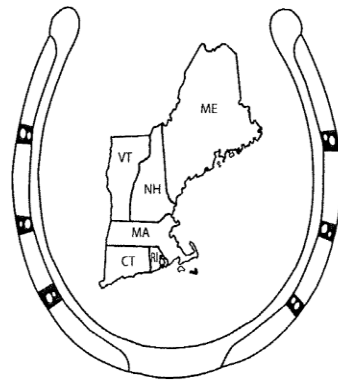
